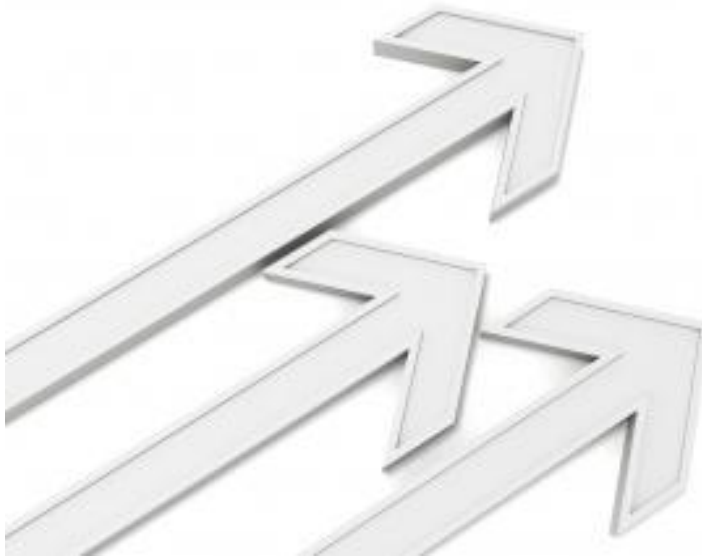

- Use the search engine to find a reputable web host that offers free webspace.



- Researching what is available and choosing the one that most suits the needs of the individual should be next. This space usually is within the range of 10 megabytes to 5 gigabytes.
- Signup with the chosen webhost using an active email address, and the username and password will be sent through the inbox after the initial signup exercise is finished.
- Log in and start featuring the intended material designed for the site.

For some the time and effort taken to design their own content is not worth the intrusion of other ads and content, especially if it is going to eventually overshadow the individual's posting.

This is basically one way of really understanding that there is nothing that is really free. Because of the no cost involved in being a part of the free web host, the individual will have no choice but to accept and hope that the other elements posted at the space will be less overwhelming and more beneficial to the individual's own agenda.

For some this scenario is acceptable because they are only interested in using the free host site as an experimental phase or a testing ground, for their endeavors, thus the other elements are not really something they would be overly concerned about.



# Chapter 4:

## *Research FTP Access*

### Synopsis

FTP is also referred to as file transfer protocol or the transfer of files into a place where it can be accessed, downloaded and uploaded. This is a secure and simple way to send and receive files. If the individual intends to download a file from the internet and create a website with it then the FTP is exactly the tool for the exercise.



## **FTP**

Initially the files are downloaded to an FTP server which should have a fairly large memory capacity to host the intended files the FTP server should have this so that the transfer can take place without any hitch.

The files can be accessed through any internet browser or any FTP software. Most of these files are available for only a short period of time and only a select few are available on a permanent base.

Accessing the files directly through the FTP address which is listed as ftp:// can be done by logging in with an ID and password.

The FTP site is usually file structured and similar to the “My Documents” on any computer and this is usually set up by an administrator.

These files may be public or private in nature and the access may include adding, moving, editing and deleting so if any of these functions do not respond to the related commands then the administrator should be informed.

Considering the FTP client is something that would create easy and regular access that is comparatively hassle free for uploads and downloads.

This would require the simple steps of drag and drop. All the frequented FTP sites and their corresponding logins and passwords can be stored conveniently in one place. Checking out the various

resources available would allow the individual to make an informed decision on which one to choose that would best suit the needs.



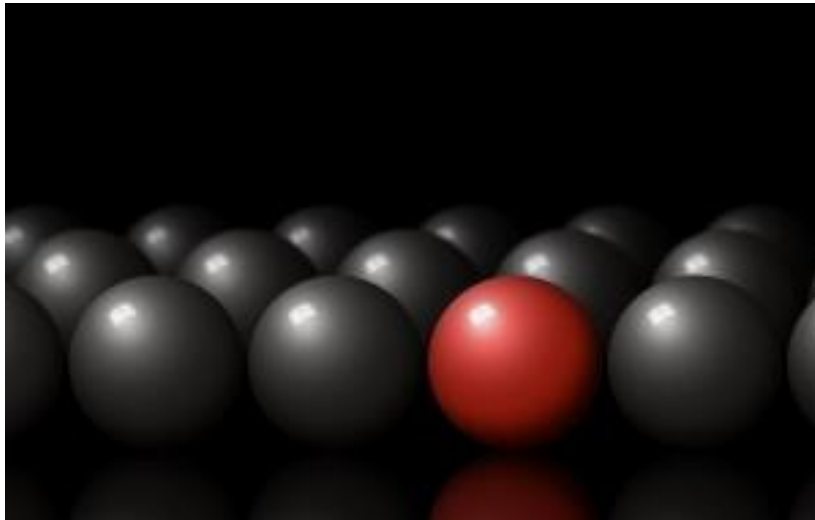
# Chapter 5:

Also there may not be facilities to certain link files such as MP3, MPEG and ZIP files, and there is no real guarantee that there will be accessible adequate uptime.

For some these limitations may not eventually be feasible for them to consider posting at the free web host and may consider other options.

This mostly happens when the webhost accept anyone and everyone with the automated instant activation system and offers features such as PHP or CGI. However all is not lost as the problems of reliability and speed access can be overcome with carefully selecting a free host that is conscientious about accepting only quality sites to host.

Different webhost have their own reliability and speed access issues but generally it all depends on the types of posting contents that will eventually dictate the two elements. However with certain criteria in place there is some control that can be exercised on the part of the webhost to ensure a reasonable level of reliability and speed access is evident.

## *Will You Have Perl And PHP*

The following are some comparative points on the merits of Perl and PHP:

- Perl application using mod\_perl are generally as fast is not faster that PHP application for most postings.
- PHP was originally written in Perl in the form of a module before the changes were made towards improvements.
- Perl has a very stable and mature database complete package which is DBI and it provides the database independent interface.

- PHP is missing many features that can be considered rather important to the serious language.
- PHP has a deliberate lack of advanced features and the web features that are currently included in the core language does make it easier to learn and use. Those without any programming experience can also easily use the PHP.
- Superficially both languages seem rather identical and Perl is not harder to read or use than PHP.



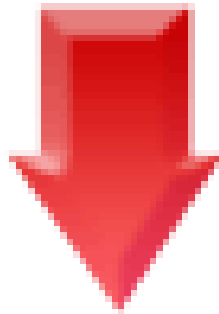
# Chapter 8:
